HOW TO USE BACD RX AK CREAM

[Imiquimod 5%]

Your provider may prescribe BACD RX AK Cream to help reduce sun damage (actinic keratoses) and/or pre-cancers, both of which can contribute to uneven skin tone, fine lines and deeper wrinkles. Please read through the below instructions before using BACD AK Cream and never hesitate to contact your provider if you have any questions or concerns.

HOW TO USE AK CREAM

- In the evening, after cleansing and your other products, apply one pump once a week only.
- AK Cream should be the last product you apply.
- Apply moisturizer *before* using AK Cream to help with dryness and skin sensitivity.
- One pump = one dose for the entire face as directed by your provider.
- Your provider may instruct you to apply it to other areas.
- On the evenings you apply AK Cream, DO NOT apply tretinoin.

- Please consult your provider if using any glycolic, salicylic acids, scrubs, etc. Mixing active / medicated products should be done with caution and under a doctor's supervision.
- It is vital to practice sun protection while using AK Cream. Apply a SPF 30+, every day.
- You may be instructed to pause AK Cream for several days before and/or after specific in-office treatments.

If you experience any irritation please contact your provider for further instructions.
